Dear Sir,

Although I tried that the Justice of Hyderabad
 and their contributions towards the Public Works
 of the State, some Justice from the Districts of
 the Province as on their part and as your case
 has sent in their contributions to be admitted
 by the Government of the Province, as far
 as is enclosed herewith. The names of the contribu-
 tors have already been announced in the local papers and
 further work of investigation they may kindly be
 carried through the Justice also according to the list
 enclosed. Most of them were paid in Hyderabad currency
 and some have been paid in R. The sum
 of the further contribution of Rs. 2000/-
 has been sent to you direct
 by the Government. The contribution of
 Rs. 1000/- has been sent to
 the Justice of Bahadur who has sent to
 direct their contributions amounting to more than
 Rs. 1000/- and they will be sending further con-
 tributions soon. I am sure that the Justice of Hyderabad
 will not look behind any other province in their
 work in the interest of their Jaid-ul-Haq.
